Residents of Pueblo County are eligible to receive a PCCLD library card. Any PCCLD location can provide a card, just bring proof of identity, birthdate, address and residency. Name and address are required on all documents provided. Electronic documents of residency may be accepted - bills, lease, etc.

Children ages 17 years and younger must have a parent or guardian present to sign for a card.
