





## Take a test

Take a test to see if you are ready to begin studying for the GED. Tests are available in the four areas of the GED: Language Arts (broken into 2 tests: reading and writing), mathematics, science and social studies.

Choose a subject area and click on “Take a Test.”



You will then see your test queue which displays the tests that you have added, but not yet taken, as well as the tests that you have already taken.




