What Happens in a Financial Navigation Session?

The free session will last approximately 30 minutes. Navigators can help you address concerns including:

- **Meeting daily living expenses**, like housing, food, and insurance
- **Maximizing income**, through accessing benefits, emergency cash assistance, and emergency loans
- **Managing debt**, from credit cards to student loans to child support
- **Avoiding predatory scams**
- **Budgeting** for future loss of income; and
- **Accessing other social services.**

A Financial Navigator will help you prioritize concerns, expenses and identify next steps.
