#### Warm-up Activity

 Each participant shared a story about an outreach experience they would like to avoid repeating. Major themes included weather related problems, communication problems, and equipment failures

#### **Outreach Planning Checklists**

- Discussed if branches or departments have outreach kits available to them or if they are assembled on a case by case basis, this varied. Members expressed interest in getting branded canopies and banners.
- There is a consensus that we avoid participating in activities that require members of the public to pay for accessibility reasons
- Kathy is considering buying a stretch table cloth to see if they are easier to use and better looking.
- Group is interested in seeing about getting clickers for counting interactions, potentially buying in bulk and distributing to branches and departments for outreach

#### At this point Jacque Carter joined the meeting

- There was a discussion about what is best practice for marketing materials at outreach events.
  - Jacque recommends just bringing Discovers because they have everything in them and you can point out one or two items if you have a good idea of what is in them.
  - You don't want to have a crowded table, regardless of if you have just Discovers because it is too overwhelming for people approaching.
  - Materials should be targeted to anticipated audience
  - Vertical marketing may help clear up table space and be more eye catching
- When reviewing checklists from Pikes Peak Library District (PPLD) some concerns were brought up:
  - Concern that checklists would be too time consuming
  - Simple is better
  - That the most important aspect of outreach is being high energy
